A group of friends regularly convened at a barbershop on Wandsworth Road in Vauxhall after their workday, a tradition that began in 2008. During these gatherings, a woman named Auntie Mary was hired to prepare meals for the group, while some members—including Nana Berndt, Snr Augustine, William Ampaw (now Apostle William Ampaw), Michael Poku, Krobia Asante, Snr Collin Adjepong, and others—savored champagne. The atmosphere often resembled an early Christmas celebration.

However, on New Year's Day, January 1, 2011, they received the tragic news of Seth Obeng Boamah's passing due to pneumonia.

This revelation came as a shock, as they were unaware that he had been experiencing homelessness and sleeping in a nearby park.

However, at Seth's funeral, the friends resolved to establish an association or club that would allow them to support any member facing difficulties. This initiative led to the formation of their club, Kinsmen, which started with approximately ten members around 2011 and has since grown to over sixty members.

The term "Kinsmen" originates from the concept of family, referring to individuals who are related to you or considered your next of kin.

THE MISSION STATEMENT OF THE CLUB

The club's primary mission was to ensure that no member would ever have to endure hardship alone. They embraced a motto of "Lean On Me," symbolizing their commitment to mutual aid and camaraderie. Meetings are held monthly, providing a space for members to share their experiences, offer advice, and plan activities that fostered their bond.

In addition to offering emotional support, the Kinsmen Club actively engaged in community service. They organized fundraising events and volunteered their time and resources to assist local charities and initiatives.

This not only strengthened their ties with the wider community but also reinforced the values of empathy and solidarity that the club was founded upon.

As the years passed, the club became a beacon of hope and friendship, with members celebrating each other's successes and providing comfort during challenging times. The legacy of Seth Obeng Boamah lived on through their actions, as they continuously worked to fulfill the promise they had made at his funeral—to be there for one another, no matter what challenges life might bring.
